



General Data Protection Regulation

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a legal framework that sets guidelines for the collection and processing of personal information of individuals within the European Union (EU). The GDPR sets out the principles for data management and the rights of the individual, while also imposing significant fines for non-compliance. The General Data Protection Regulation covers all organisations that deal with data of EU citizens, and is a critical regulation for corporate compliance officers. The GDPR came into effect across the EU on May 25, 2018.

You have no doubt been receiving many emails over recent weeks from anybody you have ever donated to or bought goods from telling you how important your privacy is to them and notifying you about their new privacy notice.

Managing Trustees' Privacy Notice

The Local Churches, Circuits and Districts within the Methodist Church in Great Britain respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal information (personal data). The **Managing Trustees' Privacy Notice** lets you know how we look after your personal data which either you provide to us or we obtain and hold about you, and it tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.
